

Documentation

1. **If both parties are South African citizens:**
 - a) Copies of your identity documents (Driver's licenses won't do).
 - b) 3 x Passport photos of the bride and groom
 - c) Completed "Your Wedding Guy Booking Form"

2. **Each party will need a witness (any person older than 18 years) to sign with you in the register:**
 - a) Copies of their identity documents.

3. **If one or both parties were married before:**
 - a) Proof that they are not married to another person.
 - i) *Stamped copy of the Final Decree of Divorce from the High Court.*
 - ii) *Copy of the death certificate.*
 - iii) *Avidavid obtained from a Commissioner of Oaths, in the event where such documentation cannot be presented.*

4. **If one or both parties are non-South African citizens:**
 - a) Both parties should set up a meeting with an immigration officer of the Department of Home Affairs, before the wedding date.
 - b) Letter from the Consulate of the country of origin, stating that the person is not involved in any marital obligations in that country.
 - c) BI-31 form, downloadable from www.doh.gov.za .
 - d) Copy of the ID document of the South African citizen plus 3 x Passport photos
 - e) Copy of the Passport and Visa of the foreigner plus 3 x Passport photos

Please Note:

The legal marriage between a *South African Citizen and a foreigner* can only be conducted by an official of the Department of Home Affairs. I can only conduct the ceremony in such a case.
